



Then in the Middle Ages, the island became a peripheral domain of the Byzantine empire in which Byzantine-style pottery was worked, and after a period of Sicilian rule,


the island again became inextricably linked to the city of Naples.

The island is spectacular, very lush and green, with spots of paradise in which to rest, sunbathe or take long walks.

It is a vast and interesting territory in many ways, primarily naturalistic and thermal. In the 29 basins present we find thermal water springs and fumaroles that have made the island a Of the most important spa destinations on the continent.

The rich vegetation lining the rocks creates a striking view of the sandy bay lapped by the turquoise sea.

La Mortella was and still is a private garden, owned by an Italian-English foundation, which opens to the public from April to October.

Lotus blossoms, bamboo and Japanese maple trees set the stage for the Thai Hall, near the Greek Theater and the burial site of Mr. and Mrs. Walton's ashes.

Wonderful views of the bay, streams and fountains enhance the scenery with some 3,000 plant species, many of them rare. Species such as tree ferns from the southern continent, aloes from South Africa, yuccas and Mexican agaves, palms, magnolias, camellias and orchids are found in the two hectares of garden.

Also in the William Walton House Museum, the foundation holds weekly musical events throughout the year.

## Sant'Angelo the Enchanted Village


